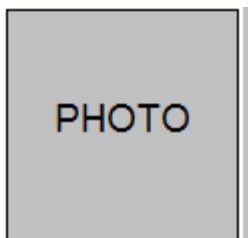

HANDWRITTEN APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

The following documents must be submitted:

1. Application form, completed, signed by the applicant, with photo attached.
2. Letter from the host Mexican institution to the Foreign Ministry's Director General for Educational and Cultural Cooperation, indicating the special program for which the scholarship is requested, the title of the conference, research, lecture or artwork, as appropriate, and the start and end dates. This does not apply for the media residency program.
3. Resume (CV) in Spanish, or the original in the applicant's native language and a Spanish translation.
4. Medical certificate stating the applicant is in good health.
5. For the artist and media residencies, as well as the Genaro Estrada Scholarship for Mexican Studies, attach:
 - An explanation of why the applicant is interested in carrying out the project in Mexico.
 - A structured work plan with a defined title and timeline of activities with a detailed explanation of the project and the anticipated end product.
6. For the Genaro Estrada program for Mexican studies, visiting professors and artist residencies, include 8 photographs (not digital) if the residency is longer than two months, or two photographs if it is shorter than two months.
7. For the artist residency program, a letter of recommendation from a well-known artist from the applicant's home country attesting to the caliber of the candidate and a portfolio with photographs of three works and various sketches (with dates of completion) that demonstrate experience in the type of project for which the artist residency is requested. For musical works, include recordings of three pieces on a good quality cassette or CD.
8. For the media residency, include a letter from the media company/institution with which the applicant works affirming his/her interest in participating in the program and committing to publish or publicize the work done in Mexico by the scholarship recipient. One copy of the published material (printed, audio or video) should be sent to the Foreign Ministry.
9. For visiting professors, the agenda previously agreed with the academic institution. Activities must total a minimum of four hours a week.
