### **Solicitud de Antecedentes Penales – Mexican Police Clearance**

The **Mexican Police Clearance** is a two-stage procedure.

First stage. Please send the following information to [sc@embamex.org.nz](mailto:sc@embamex.org.nz):

- Full name
- Postal address in NZ
- Reason for applying for the Police Clearance
- A scanned ID (passport, driver licence)
- State in Mexico where the Clearance will be requested \* (Please see note below)

The Embassy will prepare a letter that will be sent to the postal address provided.

Second stage. The letter prepared by the Embassy and the following documentation must be presented in the Procuraduría General de la República\* (Please see note below) .

If the applicant cannot go personally he/she is entitled to nominate a person to conduct the procedure.

1. Original letter prepared by the Mexican Embassy in NZ
2. Two sets of fingerprints (originals). These can be obtained from police stations in NZ
3. Valid official identification (passport, driver licence). An official translation into Spanish must be provided.
4. Proof of recent place of residence (e.g. electricity, water, telephone, bank or rates invoice) in the name of the applicant or a near relative (parents, siblings, uncles or aunts, etc.), no more than two months old. An official translation into Spanish must be provided.
5. Migratory form FM-2 or FM-3.
6. Birth certificate. A translation by a certified translator must be provided, together with an [Apostille Certificate](#).
7. Two recent (no older than 30 days) colour photographs, passport-sized, one facing frontwards and the other showing the right profile (without makeup, earrings, glasses, beard, moustache, sideboards or hair over the face – that is, with the face uncovered).
8. “[Power of Attorney](#)” type document. See [sample](#).
9. Photocopies of both sides of the current official identifications of the grantor, acceptor and two witnesses.

The "Power of Attorney" will be presented to the PGR in Mexico City together with the other documents described above.

The Police Clearance will be issued within 10 working days.

\* The Police Clearance can be requested from the Procuraduría General de la República regional offices in the following States: Aguascalientes, Baja California, Baja California Sur, Campeche, Chiapas, Chihuahua, Coahuila, Colima, Distrito Federal, Durango, Estado de México, Guanajuato, Guerrero, Hidalgo, Jalisco, Michoacán, Morelos, Nayarit, Nuevo León, Oaxaca, Puebla, Querétaro, Quintana Roo, San Luis Potosí, Sinaloa, Sonora, Tabasco, Tamaulipas, Tlaxcala, Veracruz, Yucatán and Zacatecas.
