









Message from the Ambassador

Mexico's Feminist Foreign Policy occupied a special place in the celebrations commemorating International Women's Day. The Embassy of Mexico joined efforts with the Singapore-Mexico Chamber of Commerce, bringing together prominent business, intellectual and public sector leaders, both Mexican and Singaporean, to reflect on how to access leadership positions in international markets, on a level of equality and effective recognition of rights and opportunities. Three years after its implementation, the Feminist Foreign Policy is among the three best in the world, behind Sweden and Norway, and the first in the Global South, prioritizing the gender perspective on issues of environment, peace and security, health and economic development.

The Francophone Festival, dedicated on this occasion to the theme of sport and its values, brought together local organizations and embassies, in which Mexico had a distinguished participation in the Walkathon, zumba classes, gastronomy and the screening of El Gran Salto, an inspiring documentary about Luis Rivera, a Mexican athlete who seeks Olympic glory with discipline, perseverance and respect for his family values.

In the areas of cooperation, economic promotion and investment, they highlighted: the publication of a message from the undersigned in the Directory of the Singapore Fruit and Vegetable Importers and Exporters Association, in which it is pointed out that Mexico is one of the main trading partners in the supply of fresh food, occupying fifth place in the horticultural industry and seventh place in agri-food exports in the world; support for the Mamami company for the import of organic products from Mexico; participation in the Seminar on Business Opportunities in Southeast Asia for the Mexican Poultry Sector (HALAL) and in the Third Global Connect Networking Meeting of the Singapore Business Federation (SBF); the screening of the play Like Water for Chocolate, written by Laura Esquivel, by the Royal Opera House Ballet, under the direction and musical consultancy of Alondra de la Parra; and assistance and guidance to the Durango Economic Development office to help position Durango in the Asia-Pacific region as an attractive entity for business development and investment.

The event was organized in coordination with the Singapore-Mexico Chamber of Commerce and was attended by prominent women from the business, economic, commercial and diplomatic spheres in this city-state.

The event allowed for a free exchange of views on the challenges faced by women in the Asia-Pacific region in accessing positions of power in the business world and in government, as well as strategies to be followed to promote their empowerment and encourage their greater inclusion in all areas of economic activity and advance gender equality.

The Singapore Francophonie Festival took place from March 18 to 30 at various cultural venues in Singapore. The Francophonie Ambassadors Group in Singapore, of which Ambassador Agustín García-López Loaeza has been the president since 2020, decided that the central theme of this year's festival would be sports.

The opening of the Festival took place at the International French School (IFS) on Saturday, March 18, with a "Walkathon". Every year the IFS organizes this sporting event to raise funds for humanitarian causes. The community is invited to run as many laps as possible around the running track and their efforts are subsequently rewarded with donations to Singapore charities.

On March 10, the Head of the Foreign Ministry, Minister Rodolfo Quilantán, and Mario Calderón, Assistant of the Economic Promotion and Liaison Department of the Foreign Ministry, held a meeting with representatives of the Malaysian company Mamami Shoppe, which is seeking to open a subsidiary in Singapore to facilitate trade in healthy organic products from various countries, including Mexico.

The Director of Business Development, Patricia Vázquez, informed us that the company currently imports chia from Mexico and is in negotiations to import pecan nuts.

During the meeting, the Embassy was asked to identify Mexican suppliers for products such as quinoa, and various types of beans, among others.

The Embassy of Mexico and the Singapore-Mexico Chamber of Commerce participated in the 3rd networking meeting organized by the Global Connect unit of the Singapore Business Federation.
