STATEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE GROUP OF FRIENDS FOR WOMEN IN NUCLEAR

Mexico has the honour of delivering this statement as Co-Chair of the *Group of Friends for Women in Nuclear*.

Our Group comprises 34 Member States from all eight regional groups, united in our objective of increasing to parity the representation of women in the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

Realising gender equality through women's empowerment is in our view a crucial management objective, which can support and advance the Agency's effective implementation of its mandate to accelerate and enlarge the contribution of atomic energy to peace, health and prosperity throughout the world.
