REPLACEMENT OF THE RESIDENT CARD OF MEXICO (LOSS/THEFT/DAMAGE)

Requirements:

1. Visa Application.

Must be written in [English](#) or [Spanish](#) and signed the same as the signature in the passport.

2. Valid passport original and one photocopy of the main page.

6 months validity rule

3. One passport size color picture.

Front view, no eyeglasses and white background.

4. Original and one photocopy of the Alien Registration Card (ARC)

Or the document that proves the applicant is a foreign legal resident of South Korea. This only applies for no Korean citizens.

5. Visa fee around 70,000KRW (depending on the USD/KRW exchange rate)

We only accept cash KOREAN WON to be paid after the visa interview. We do not accept credit/debit cards. Non-refundable if not approved.

6. Original and copy of the official police report that states the theft, loss or damage of the resident card if Mexico.

7. Resident card (copy of the resident card in case of theft or less, or original in case of damage).

For this type of visa, you do not need an appointment, please send us an email with the requirements attach and explaining your situation, we will reply to you as soon as possible with the available date to come to the Embassy.

After entering Mexico with this kind of visa, you should go to the nearest “Instituto nacional de migración” (INM) office to get your resident ID card.

Important notes:

1. After the foreign person submits the application, the consular office will consult to the Institute of Migration the authenticity of the loss card, which might take up to 2 working days.
2. Once the Institute replies with the authorization (up to 5 working days), the consular office will contact the applicant to issue the visa (up to 3 working days).
