



NON PAID ACTIVITIES UP TO 180 DAYS **(tourist/transit/short business trip)**

Requirements:

1. **Visa Application.** Must be written in [English](#) or [Spanish](#) and signed the same as the signature in the passport. [Download here in English or Spanish](#)
2. **Valid passport original and one photocopy of the main page**
6 months validity rule
3. **One passport size color picture**
Front view, no eyeglasses and white background.
4. **Original and one photocopy of the Alien Registration Card (ARC)**
Or the document that proves the applicant is a foreign legal resident of South Korea. This only applies for non Korean citizens
5. **Visa fee around 70,000KRW (depending on the USD/KRW exchange rate)**
We only accept cash KOREAN WON to be paid after the visa interview. We do not accept credit/debit cards. Non-refundable if not approved.

6. Proof of economic solvency:

a) Original and copy of documents showing that the applicant has a job or pension that yields a **monthly income of \$1,203,359 KRW** after taxes during the **previous 4 months** (bring the last 4 months of your paystubs and the last 4 bank statements that shows the direct deposit of your salary) 은행 거래 내역서 (입금 내역만)

and proof of stable employment with a minimum of one year (bring a verification of employment letter that confirms you have been employed for the past year.

b) Original and copy of proof of personal bank accounts with **monthly savings balance of at least \$3,610,078 during the previous 4 months** of statements (bring the last 4 months of your bank statements). 은행 거래 내역서 (입금 내역만)

*All bank statements must be original.

*If you use paperless banking, you must have your statements stamped by your bank. We do not accept simple prints from downloaded bank statements.

*The Documents must be in English or Spanish.

Important notes:

1. To apply for a visa first you will need an appointment at the booking page: <https://citas.sre.gob.mx/>

2. The issuance of visa might take up to 10 working days after the interview day, If necessary, you might be asked to support your application with supplementary documentation.
3. In the case of a spouse, parent or child who is economically dependent upon the foreigner holding the Mexican visa, the person may simply prove the family relationship with official documents (original) and prove economic solvency per each relative.
4. If you present a document issued from a country different than Mexico or South Korea, it must come with an apostille or legalization as applicable, and with an official translation to Spanish, this applies also for the bank statement.
