Disease free: Classic swine fever and Aujesky disease. Mexico exports 40,000 tons annually to Japan, 30% of which is frozen and 70% is fresh. Sonora accounts for 82% of the national pork exports to Japan







#### **BEEF**

Health regulations:

TIF (Federal Inspection Type).

USDA (United States Department of Agriculture) certificates for exports.

Disease free: Boophillus Tick, Tuberculosis, Brucellosis and Paralytic Rabies.
