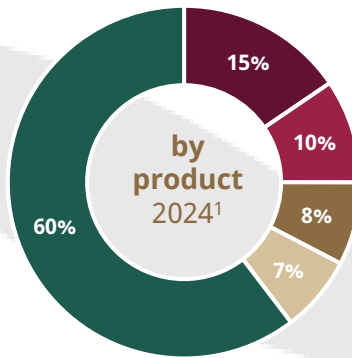

Connecticut's trade with Mexico is larger than the United States' trade with Greece.

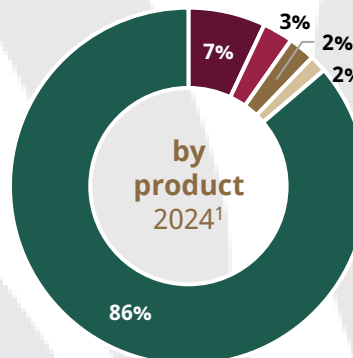

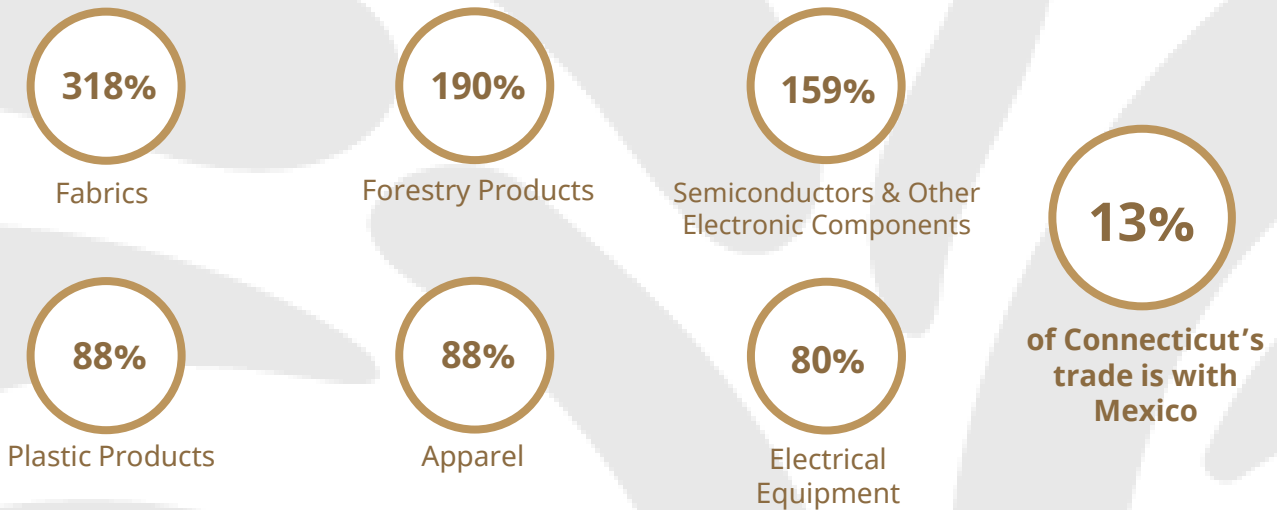
