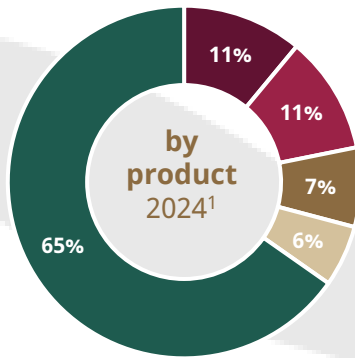

DC's total trade with Mexico is larger than the total United States' trade with Rwanda.

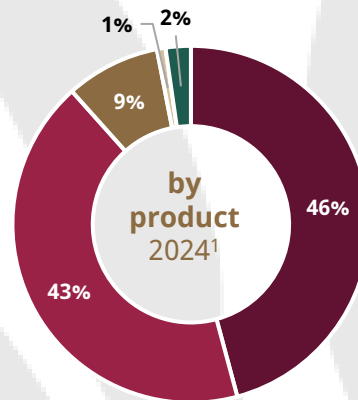

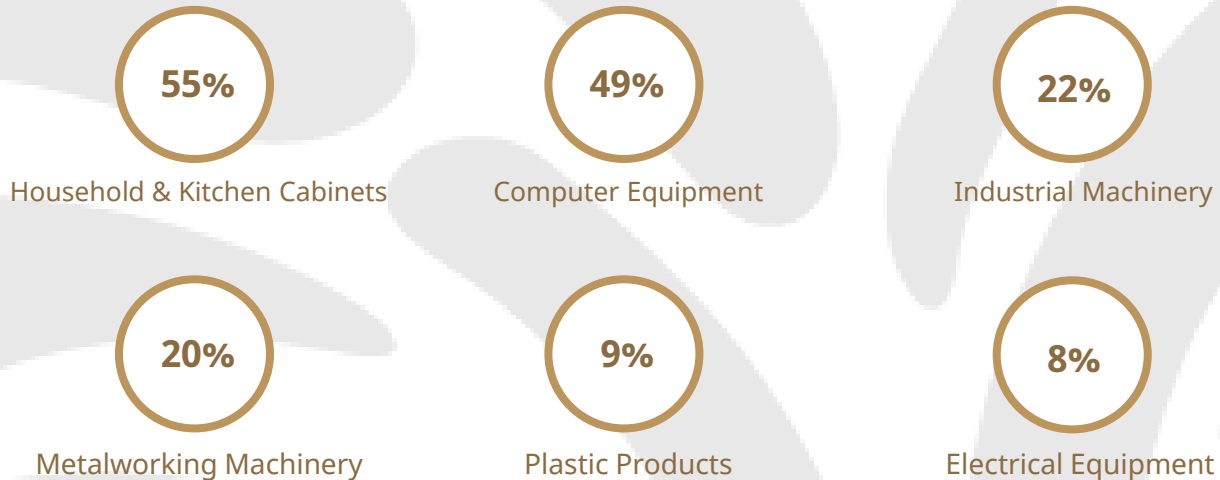
