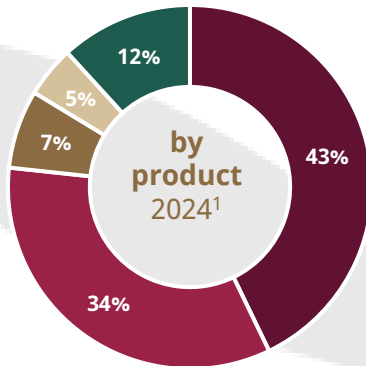

Louisiana's trade with Mexico is greater than the United States' trade with Panama.

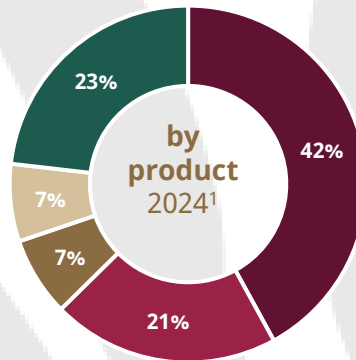
