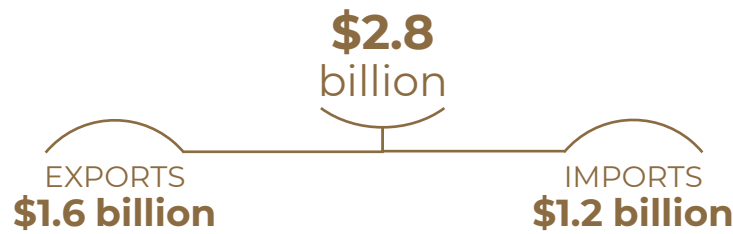




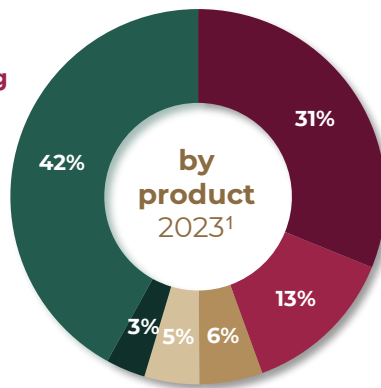
## Total trade in 2023<sup>1</sup>



Colorado's total trade with Mexico is larger than the United States' total trade with Uruguay.

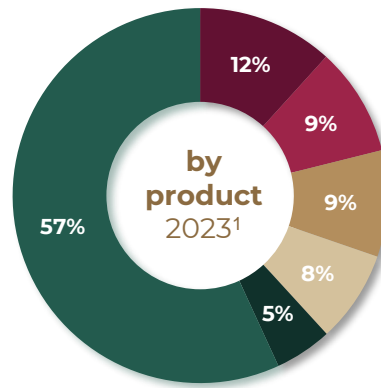

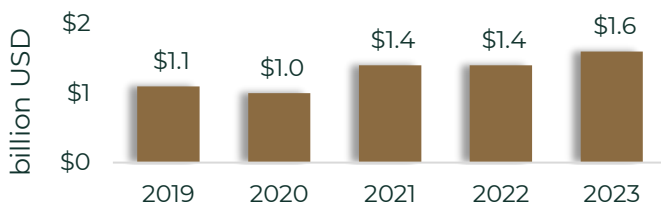

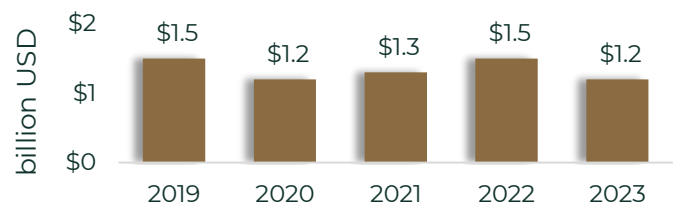

### Mexican investments in Colorado



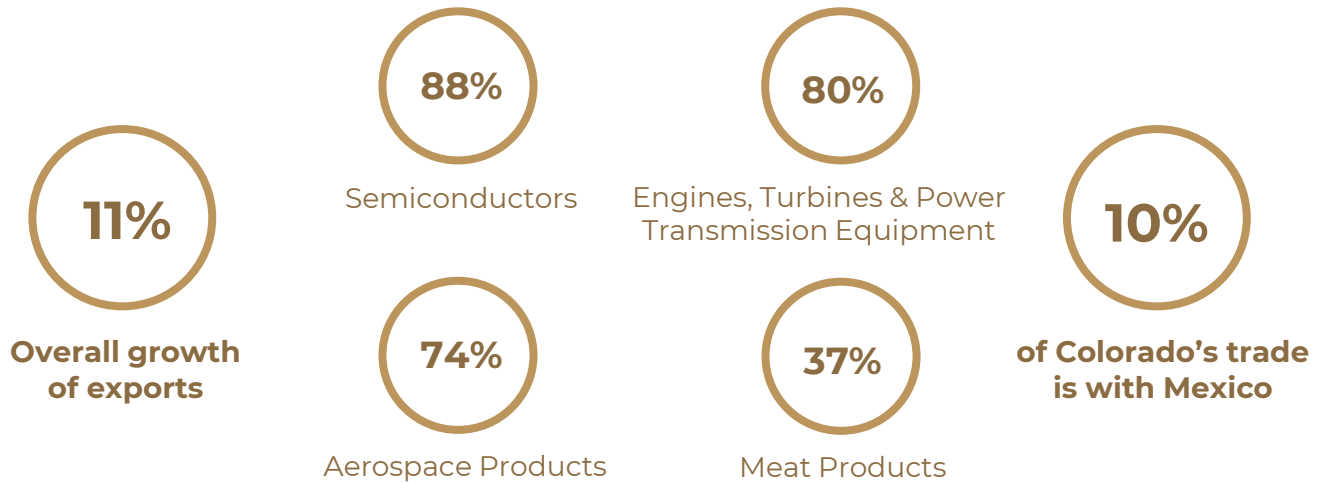

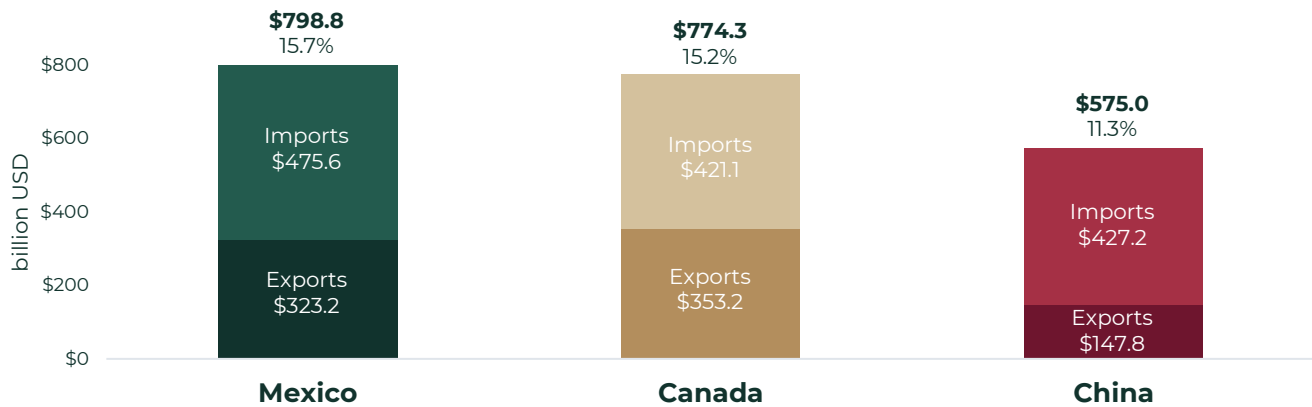


## Colorado's most exported products to Mexico continue to grow (2022 - 2023)<sup>1</sup>
