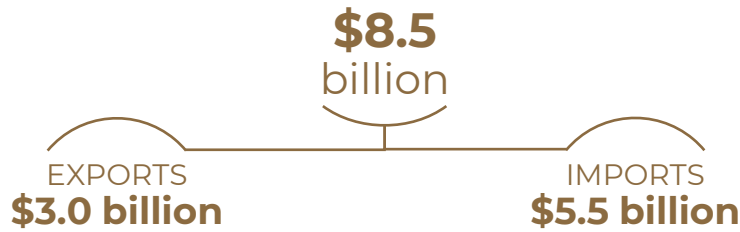




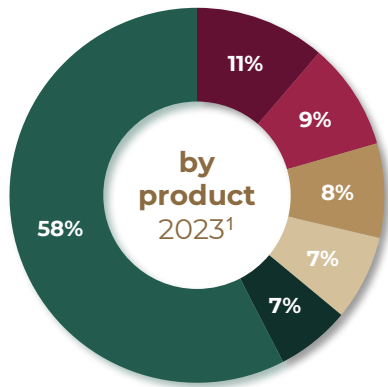
## Total trade in 2023<sup>1</sup>



South Carolina's trade with Mexico is greater than the United States' trade with Nigeria.

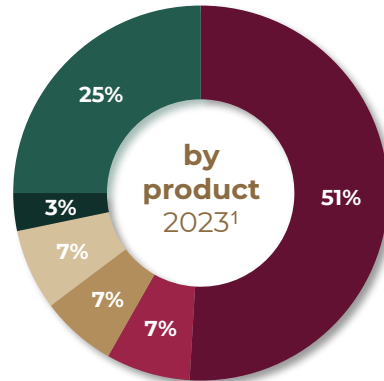

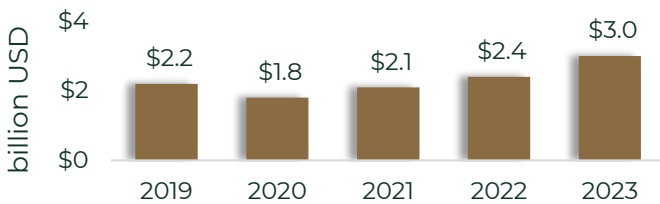

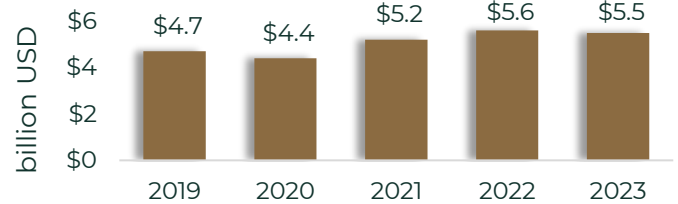

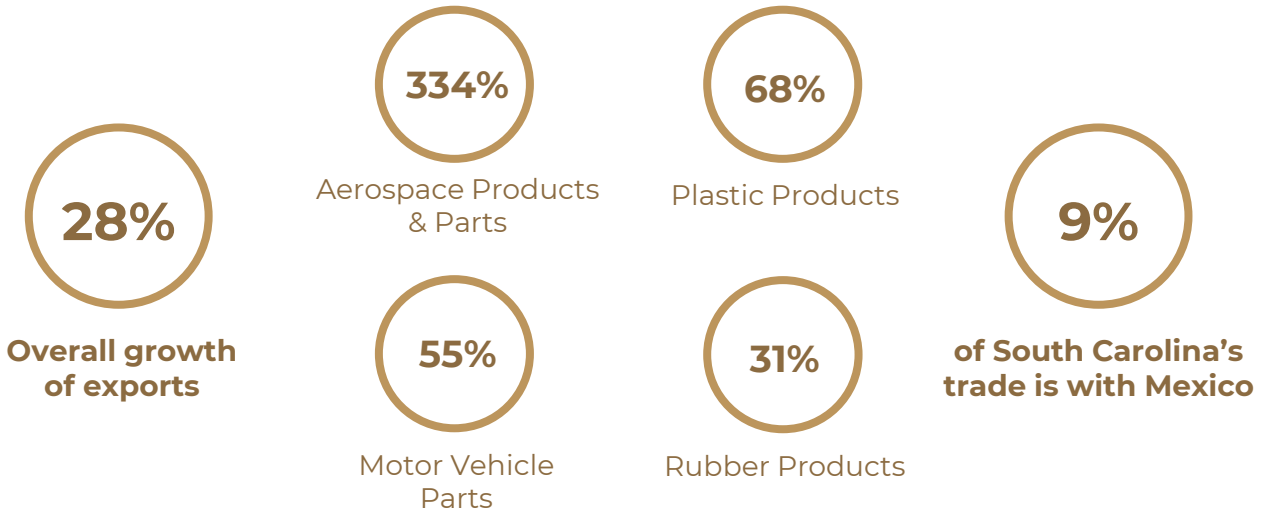
