## 1. INITIAL PROVISIONS AND GENERAL DEFINITIONS

### México's main objectives

- Maintaining the legal structure of the 1994 North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA).
- Improving communication between the member countries.
- Updating NAFTA provisions.
- Including an agreement revision mechanism to prevent the Agreement from losing its ability to respond and adapt to new economic circumstances.

### Benefits for Mexico

- Improves communication between the Parties by creating a Treaty Coordinator figure and establishing contact points for specific issues.
- Updates the national security provision included in the 1947 GATT.
- Establishes provisions that regulate the protection of personal information and access to information.

### Chapter's main provisions

- Affirmation of existing rights and obligations among the Parties under WTO Agreements (**Article 1.2**).
- General definitions in accordance to WTO Agreements (**Article 1.5**).
