## 2. NATIONAL TREATMENT AND MARKET ACCESS FOR GOODS

### Mexico's main objective

- Modernizing and establishing new trade provisions in order to ensure further transparency and certainty in the application of non-tariff measures.

### Benefits for Mexico

- Maintains tariff-free product access to the US market.
- Preserves disciplines which regulate the application of import and export restrictions.
- Incorporates disciplines to ensure transparency in the application of certain non-tariff measures.

### Chapter's main provisions

- Provisions to update disciplines on temporary importation of goods and re-imported goods after repair or alteration, as well as commercial samples and printed advertising materials, among others **(Article 2.7)**.
- Provisions that reaffirm the principle of free trade for all originating goods. Additionally, it stipulates the prohibition to apply export taxes and to demand performance requirements in order to issue import licenses and tariff deferral programs; includes disciplines on import and export restrictions; and establishes a duty drawback regime **(Article 2.11)**.
- Contemplates new disciplines on transparency regarding import and export licensing **(Article 2.13)**.
- New provisions regarding the trade of remanufactured goods in the region.
- Establishes a Committee on Trade to serve as a consultative body for the member countries **(Article 2.17)**.
