
32. EXCEPTIONS AND GENERAL PROVISIONS

Mexico's Objectives

- Establishing the exceptions and general provisions of the Treaty.

Benefits for Mexico

- Establishes the exceptions of the Treaty's Chapters, as well as exceptions regarding various issues.

Chapter's Main Provisions

- Establishes that nothing in the agreement shall be utilized to oblige a Party to provide or allow access to information whose disclosure it considers contrary to its essential security interests **(Article 32.2)**.
- The treaty does not prevent a party from adopting or maintaining a measure that it deems necessary to comply with its legal obligations for indigenous peoples **(Article 32.5)**.
- Establishes a commitment by member countries to inform their counterparts if either country seeks to establish a Free Trade Agreement with a non-market economy country **(Article 32.10)**.
