

United States- Mexico- Canada Agreement (USMCA)

Energy

This Chapter has the objective of promoting and guaranteeing full **respect for** the sovereignty of Mexico over its hydrocarbons, by recognizing its direct, inalienable and imprescriptible property over them.

General provisions:

- The Parties confirm their **full respect for sovereignty and their sovereign right to regulate** with respect to matters addressed in this Chapter in accordance with their respective Constitution and domestic laws, in the full exercise of their democratic processes.
- The sovereignty of the country in the energy sector is confirmed, making clear the faculties of the Mexican State. One of the central aspects, is to recognize the right of Mexico to regulate and modify its laws.
- Mexico achieves full recognition of its sovereignty and capacity to change its legal framework, including the Constitution.
- Reaffirms its direct, inalienable and imprescriptible ownership over hydrocarbons.
- It establishes **mechanisms to provide legal certainty** to service providers, exporters, importers and investors that participate in the energy sector.
- It assures a special treatment through a generic criteria of equity, assuring the Parties of USMCA the treatment given under any other international agreement signed by Mexico, until the entry into force of USMCA.
