


TOTAL TRADE WITH MEXICO IN 2020¹










MEXICO WAS THE UNITED STATES' #2 TRADING PARTNER IN 2020¹



U.S. – Mexico Trade



Jobs: Trade with Mexico supports 5 million American jobs throughout the nation, which equals 12.2% of all trade-related jobs in the U.S.²



Exports: In 2020, Mexico was one of the top three merchandise export markets for 29 U.S. states.¹



Total Trade: Trade with Mexico reached \$538.1 billion in 2020, which equals about 14.3% of all U.S. exports.¹



U.S. Manufacturers: U.S.-manufactured goods trade with Mexico supports the jobs of more than 147 thousand men and women across the United States.² Mexico is one of the top three purchasers of manufacturing exports for 32 U.S. states.¹



Essential for Farmers and Ranchers: U.S. agricultural exports to Mexico have increased 5x since the implementation of NAFTA, from \$3.6 billion in 1993 to \$18 billion in 2020. Mexico purchased 12.4% of all U.S. agricultural exports in 2020.3



Powers the Service Economy: U.S. services exports to Mexico have exponentially grown 217% since NAFTA's implementation, from \$10.3 billion in 1993 to \$32.9 billion in 2019.4 U.S. service exports supports over 4.5 million U.S. jobs.²
