On behalf of our Mexican parent company Nemak, owned by the ALFA group, we are proud to be here today. We are one of the world's largest producer of aluminum engine parts and within this, the light metal aluminum foundry Nemak Gyor Kft is producing close to 3 million cylinder heads / year with approximately 55 billion HUF revenue / year employing today up to a thousand highly qualified employees.

In the Hungarian casting industry and within this, as casting supplier to the automotive industry: Nemak Gyor is a key light metal alloy die casting manufacturer.
