

Hungarian Ambassador receives the Decoration of the Mexican Order of the Aztec Eagle from the Government of Mexico

The President of Mexico, Enrique Peña Nieto grants the highest state decoration for foreigners to Teréz Dehelánné Dörömbözi, former ambassador of Hungary in Mexico

BUDAPEST-As published in the [Official Journal of the Federation](#), the Decoration of the Mexican Order of the Aztec Eagle was awarded to the Hungarian diplomat, who was extraordinary and plenipotentiary ambassador of Hungary in Mexico between 2009-2013, for her significant contribution to the development and deepening of friendship and cooperation between the two countries.

The Journal states that ambassador Dörömbözi made distinguishable efforts to impulse the bilateral political dialogue as well as to promote the economic relations. It was in this spirit, that could take place the VII Political Consultations between the ministries of foreign affairs in 2010, the first Joint Economic Committee's Meeting in 2011, the signature of the Double Taxation Avoidance Agreement and Mexico's participation in the first ever Latin-American Forum in Budapest, both in 2012. The activities of the ambassador also helped the visible growth of the bilateral trade, where the total trade of products could reach as high as 1.3 billion USD in 2013. In the field of bilateral cultural cooperation her work did not remain unseen either. Several outstanding cultural projects and cultural and educational cooperation programs signed marked her activity as an ambassador.

Just to highlight some: The world famous Hungarian pianist, [Gergely Bogányi](#) gave two full-night concerts in the Palacio de Bellas Artes, Mexico's most renowned concert hall, or [Roby Lakatos](#) participated in the International Cervantino Festival in 2011.

The Mexican Order of the Aztec Eagle was established in 1932 by the Mexican State with the purpose of acknowledging foreign nationals who has done prominent services to the Mexican Nation or humanity. Among its recipients there is, Queen Sophia of Spain, Nelson Mandela or Bill Gates.

The Decoration will be bestowed upon Ms. Teréz Dehelánné Dörömbözi by Ambassador of Mexico, Isabel Bárbara Téllez Rosete on November 17, 2014 in a ceremonial act in Budapest. The event will be an honorable moment of the diplomatic relations between Mexico and Hungary which marks its 40th Anniversary in 2014.
