



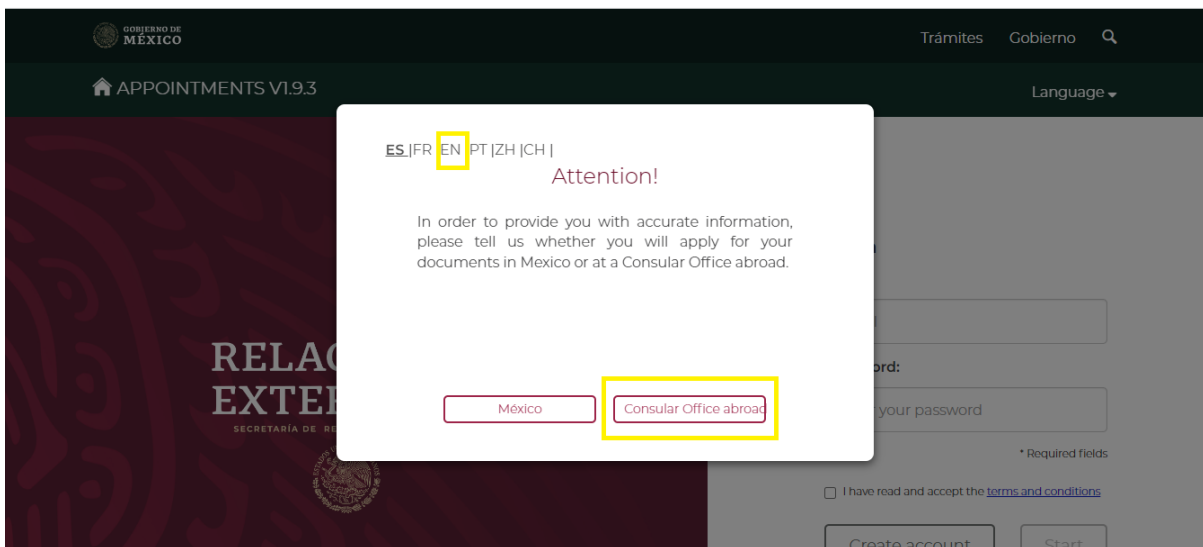
As of September 1, 2021, you can schedule your appointment at the Consular Section of the Embassy of Mexico in Malaysia for passport, visa, or legalizations at:

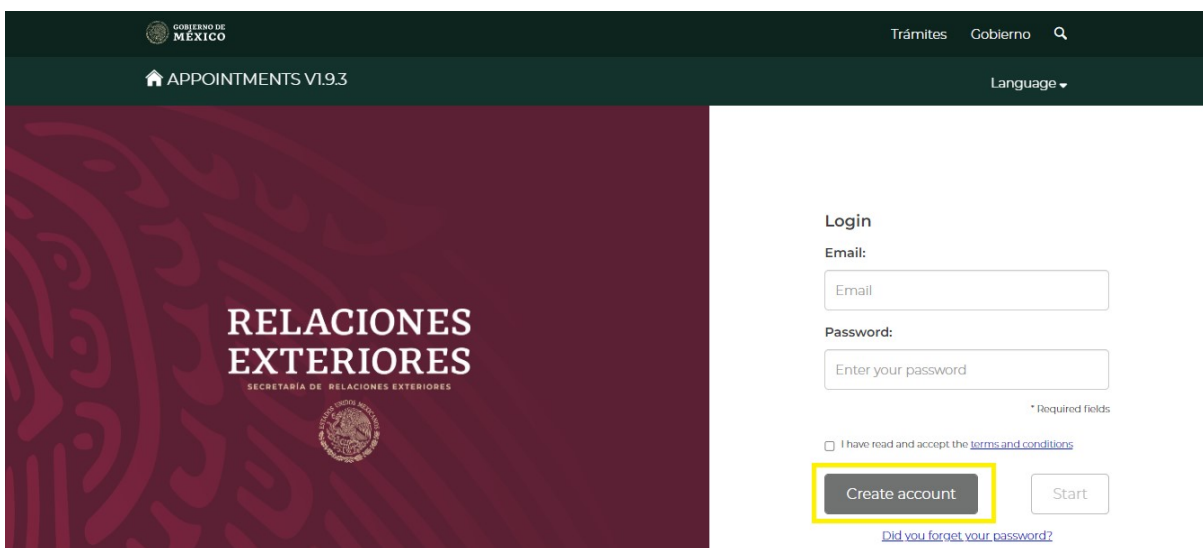
- **How to create an account?**

Please, follow these steps:

1. Go to <https://citas.sre.gob.mx>
Click on “EN” for **English** and then “Consular Office abroad”



2. Click on “Create account”

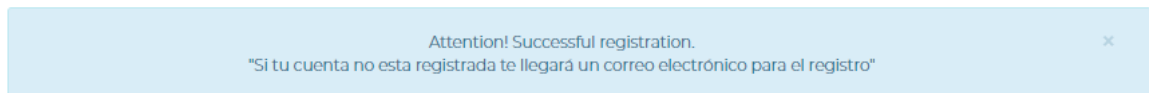


2.1 Fill in all the fields with the requested information.

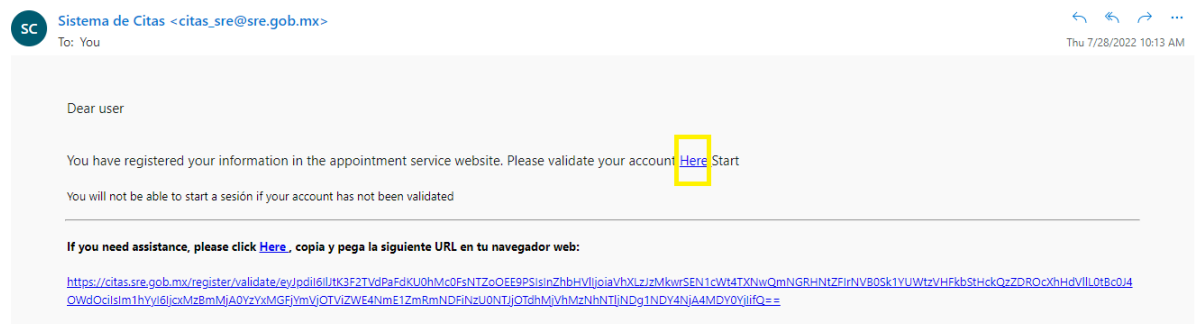
