

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUING OF A TOURIST VISA

You can enter Mexico as a tourist when planning to carry out recreation or health-related activities; non-profit artistic, cultural or sporting activities; attend conferences, conventions, trade fairs or exhibitions when participation is of a cultural, educational, informative, sporting or artistic nature and does not involve the promotion of goods or services; and to participate in summer courses or student exchange programmes.

Please send by email to consular@embamex.org.nz all of the following documents to our offices for evaluation:

1. A [completed visa application form](#). Please affix a recent passport-sized photograph.
2. Scan of first page of passport with at least six months validity from the intended date of entry.
3. Proof of solvency - one of the following must be provided:
 - a) A letter from the place of work outlining salary and the period of time spent working for the company;
 - b) Proof of property ownership registered under the applicant's name;
 - c) A current savings account statement with an average yearly balance of US\$2,000.00; or
 - d) An international credit card statement with a credit limit of at least USD\$1,500.00

Once the documents are received, and if these are approved, the applicant will need to come to the Embassy of Mexico for an interview. Please note that there will be no exceptions to this requirement. In normal circumstances, the visa will be ready for collection later the same day.

Please note that as of 1 May 2010, all foreigners who are in possession of a valid USA visa do not also need to apply for a visa to gain entry into Mexico.
