

## VISA WITH PERMISSION TO CONDUCT REMUNERATED ACTIVITIES

Foreigners who wish to travel to Mexico with the intent to conduct remunerated activities must have an offer of employment. The Mexican institution, company or person who intends to hire the foreigner must submit the visa application directly to the National Migration Institute (Instituto Nacional de Migración, INM) in Mexico. The Embassy or Consulate may only issue a visa if it has been authorized by the INM.

Once the foreigner has the corresponding authorization, he must apply personally at any Mexican Consulate with the following documents:

Passport (Original and Copy)	Mandatory
Photo (32mm x 26mm) frontal view, color, white background, no glasses	Mandatory
Proof of legal stay in Singapore For Singaporeans: NRIC For Foreigners: Work Permit, Employment or Social Pass; For Visitors: Immigration Entry/Departure Form	Mandatory
Fee (\$46.00 SGD, to be paid in cash at the Consular Section)	Mandatory
Letter from employer	Mandatory
Letter of invitation from Mexico	Mandatory
INM Authorization Letter	Mandatory
Proof of personal financial means (i.e. three recent bank account statements) (original and copy)	Mandatory
Copy of the flight itinerary & hotel reservation	Mandatory

The Consular officer may ask you to provide further documents. The visa will be subject to approval after the consular interview.
