

STUDENT TEMPORARY RESIDENT VISA

Foreigners who wish to remain in Mexico for a period greater than 180 days to attend courses, pursue studies, or conduct research projects at an educational institution belonging to the National Educational System in Mexico must comply with the following requirements:

In compliance with all requirements a valid single-entry visa will be issued. Once the applicant has entered Mexican territory, he or she must, within the first 30 calendar days, apply to the National Migration Institute (INM) for a temporary resident card.

¹ Family Unity Applications may only be accepted at a Consular Office if the foreigner with temporary or permanent resident status in Mexico or Mexican citizen accompanies the family member at the time the application is submitted.
