VISA WITH PERMISSION TO CONDUCT REMUNERATED ACTIVITIES

- Foreigners who wish to travel to Mexico with the intent to conduct remunerated activities **must be holders of an offer of employment**.
- The Mexican institution, company or person who intends to hire the foreigner must submit the visa application directly to the National Migration Institute (Instituto Nacional de Migración, INM) in Mexico.
- The Embassy or Consulate will only issue a visa if it has been authorized by the INM.

Once the foreigner has the authorization from INM, the person must apply personally at any Mexican Consulate with the following documents:

The letter, addressed to the Embassy, must include the barticulars and registration number of the company/institution; contact information; description of the activity to be conducted by the applicant; intended period stay in Mexico of the applicant; future salary; and photocopy an official ID of the person signing the letter of invitation.	he he of

Letter from employer (original) The letter, addressed to the Embassy, must inform on the current employment and monthly salary. If a transfer, please indicate the activity to be performed by the applicant and the intended period of stay in Mexico. **Proof of personal finance** (last 3 months, original and photocopy) The bank statement/pay slips must be stamped and signed by the bank/person in charge. Proof of personal skills for the intended activity (original and photocopy) These may include diplomas, certificates, etc. Copy of the flight itinerary & hotel reservation Visa Fee (to be paid in cash in SGD at the Consular Section)

Note: The Consular officer may ask you to provide further documents. The visa will be subject to approval after the consular interview.
