INVESTMENT

According to data provided by our Ministry of Economy, the cumulative investment of South Africa in Mexico from 1999 to 2020 amounted to 149 million dollars, with 39 SA companies. Aspen (pharmaceutical products), Blue Label (electronic services for point-of-sale terminals), Dimension Data (technological services for companies) and SRK Consulting (consulting for mining projects), Mix Telematics (communications) are the main South African companies with presence in our country (41st place, 0.02% of total investments).

Mexican companies with presence in South Africa, such as Imbera (Inochill), Katcon, Metalsa and BinBit, closed operations between 2019 and 2020.

Mexican companies Cosmotel, and Bimbo have operations in South Africa.

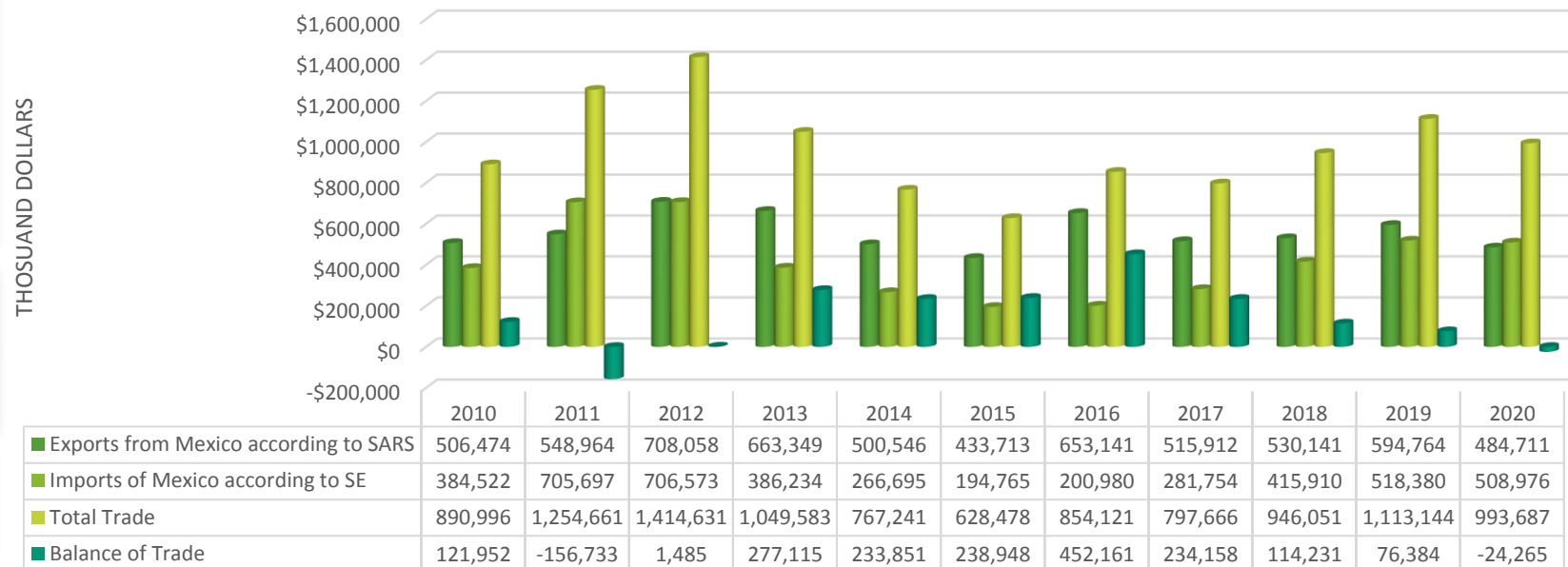
BILATERAL ECONOMIC RELATIONSHIP MEXICO – SOUTH AFRICA 2020-2021

TRADE

Due to COVID, in 2020, trade between Mexico and South Africa was of 993,867 million dollars, according to the certificates of origin of the respective exports.

Mexican exports in 2020 included mainly malt beer, processors, wheel tractors, tequila, memory cards (smart cards), memory units, electronic devices, auto parts, adapters, modular circuits, intravenous catheters, massage devices, machinery in general and minerals
