## MIGRATORY BIRDS

-  Mexico's geographical location and its abundant forests, rainforests, wetlands and mountain ranges attract millions of birds. Our ecosystems are ideal places for them to rest, feed and find shelter. [bit.ly/2qtbXDU](https://bit.ly/2qtbXDU)
-  Every year, the birds migrate from the Arctic to South America, Central America and North America using three routes in Mexico: the Pacific, Central and Gulf routes. Hundreds of species of migratory birds visit Mexico every year. [bit.ly/2qtbXDU](https://bit.ly/2qtbXDU)
-  Biological corridors in #Mexico are migratory routes for birds. The steady winds of the Isthmus of Tehuantepec in Oaxaca can help birds fly for entire days.

-  The history of vanilla begins with Mexico's pre-Hispanic cultures, which used it to flavor a cocoa-based drink called "Xocolatl" [bit.ly/2po9F4l](https://bit.ly/2po9F4l)
