



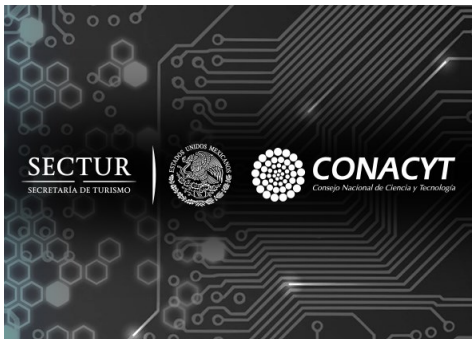




QUERETARO MACRO HIGHWAY BYPASS
