REVILLAGIGEDO NATIONAL PARK

- The #Revillagigedo Archipelago is located in the Mexican Pacific Ocean, about 340 miles from Los Cabos, Baja California Sur and 550 miles from Manzanillo, Colima. It is classified as a priority marine conservation site and is extremely important due to its enormous biodiversity, its ecosystems and superlative natural phenomena. bit.ly/2ybWkEI
