SUMMIT AGAINST CANCER

- #Mexico is working to reduce exposure to risk factors associated with cancer, to reduce the cancer mortality rate and improve patients' quality of life. bit.lv/2zGu79E

- World Health Organization (#WHO) data shows that 8.8 million deaths were caused by cancer in 2015, or almost one of every six deaths. bit.ly/2zGu79E
- About 70% of cancer deaths occur in low and middle income countries, where few patients have access to treatment.
