- #LearnMore There have been 8 oil auctions this year with two more to go. In addition, planning is underway for a third auction of unconventional sources of energy in the Burgos Basin in #Tamaulipas. bit.ly/2sDuIqs
- f In October, @Pemex will launch tenders for exploration and production farmouts, strategic partnerships with the state-owned oil and gas company. bit.ly/2sDulqs
- #GoodNews two large transmission lines will be tendered and the #UniversalPowerServiceFund will continue installing solar panels and distribution lines to bring more electricity to isolated communities. bit.ly/2sDuIqs
- Over 180 million pesos from the #UniversalPowerServiceFund will be invested in more than 238 communities to achieve 99% electricity coverage in #Campeche this year. bit.ly/2sDuIqs
