TELECOM REFORM

- There are 71.3 million internet users in #Mexico, 30.4 million more than at the start of this administration. #TelecomReform bit.ly/2GySSEi
- More than half of #Mexico's households have internet.

- Under the current administration, 30 million homes (94.3%) in #Mexico received a digital signal in 2017, up from 12.2 million homes (42.2%) in 2012. #TelecomReform bit.ly/2GySSEi
- 93.2% of households in #Mexico have at least one television and 70.5% have at least one digital television, an increase of 2.6% over 2016. #TelecomReform #LearnMore bit.ly/2CzuJLB

SAC ACTUN

- #GoodNews #Mexico wants the #SacActun system declared a @UNESCO mixed world heritage site because it has both natural and cultural elements of universal value. bit.ly/2EFzn0u
- #SacActun could be the most important underwater archaeological site in the world, with sites related to the first settlers of the Americas, Pleistocene megafauna, and more than a hundred associated with the Mayan civilization. bit.ly/2EFzn0u
- Access to the #SacActun system is via 248 cenotes, and 198 archaeological sites have been found, of which 138 seem to be related to the Mayan civilization and at least two, to pre-ceramic skeletal remains that are at least 9,000 years old. bit.ly/2EFzn0u
- Just like a big fish eating a little fish, #SacActun has absorbed the Dos Ojos system, and now covers a distance equivalent to that between #Cancun and #Chetumal. bit.ly/2EFzn0u
