- Over 500 million pesos have been invested in the new #AcapulcoAirport terminal. At 19,000 m2, it is 7,000 m2 larger than the building it replaces. bit.ly/2H32lnE
- The new #AcapulcoAirport terminal is 91% complete and will be operational in less than two months. Part of the original building is being demolished and a larger, more modern and more efficient building with an annual capacity for 1.3 million passengers is being built. bit.ly/2H32lnE
