HALAL-CERTIFIED PLANTS

- #Mexico's strategy of diversifying its agrifood markets has led to an upward trend in the production and export of agricultural and fishery products, with a year-end total of USD 35 billion in global food sales expected. bit.ly/2JsvBVT
- With a global halal market of over 1.8 billion Muslims, #Mexico began the process of #Halal certification. Today, there are 61 certified Mexican agrifood plants. bit.ly/2JsvBVT
- #Mexico is the seventh biggest producer in the world of animal protein. Locally, 60% of the protein consumed is export-quality chicken and eggs. bit.ly/2JsvBVT
