- In the first half of the year, 20.6 million international tourists traveled to #Mexico, 7.3% more than the 19.2 million recorded for the same period in 2017. bit.ly/2N5EU0C

- Some Purépecha legends say that the #achoque, or waterdog, was an evil god. When the other gods wanted to banish him to the underworld, he hid in Lake #Patzcuaro as an achoque. #MegadiverseMexico bit.ly/20VXM2y
