

VISITOR VISA WITHOUT PERMISSION TO ENGAGE IN REMUNERATED ACTIVITIES.

Requirements:

- 1) Visa application, printed on one page, double sided, properly completed and signed.
- 2) Valid passport or travel document.
- 3) One recent color photo measuring 3.0 x 3.5 cm, front view, with white background, without glasses and/or piercing.
- 4) Document proving the applicant's valid legal status in Sweden if the applicant is not a Swedish citizen.
- 5) Consular fee, if applicable.
- 6) Official documents proving any of the following situations:

a) Proof of long-term residency ("Arraigo")

- Original and copy of property deed duly registered in the name of the applicant, **and** a letter from his/her employer stating position and length of employment (at least one year), **or**
- Original and copy of property deed duly registered in the name of the applicant **and** official document proving total or partial ownership of a business, for a minimum of two years, issued by the competent authorities.

b) Economic solvency

- Original and copy of investment documents or bank account statements for the last six months, showing a monthly average balance of 16,500 SEK, **or**
- Original and copy of documents confirming employment (official letter from the applicant's employer in the company's official stationery, duly stamped and signed, **and** monthly payment slips) or pension for the last six months with a monthly income of at least 5,000 SEK after taxes.

Note: Foreigners who are full time students (graduate or postgraduate studies) must present proof of enrollment (official letter from the university, duly stamped and signed) **and** monthly income (salary, pension or scholarship) of at least 3,500 SEK during the last six months.

c) Invitation letter

- Original letter from the organization, public or private institution in Mexico that invites the foreigner to participate in non-remunerated activities. The letter should contain the following information:
 - Applicant's full name and nationality,
 - Name, registration number, address and main purpose of the organization or institution,
 - Full description of activities and/or project to be performed in Mexico (the foreigner's activity must be related to the purpose of the inviting organization or institution), length of stay or approximate date of completion,
 - If applicable, statement that the inviting organization or institution will cover the applicant's living expenses while in Mexico and his/her trip back to the applicant's place of residence,
 - Copy of an official identification (passport, IFE, cédula profesional) of the person signing the invitation letter.
- Official documents proving that the applicant has the experience, capacity, skills or expertise to perform the activities s/he has been invited to participate in, original and a photocopy.
- Proof of economic solvency, as indicated in section 6, paragraph b), except when the inviting organization or institution is covering the applicant's travel costs and stay in Mexican territory and states so explicitly in the invitation letter.

d) Scientific research or the collecting of samples in Mexican territory or jurisdictional waters:

Once the applicant has obtained authorization from the competent national authorities for waters under Mexican jurisdiction, s/he must present:

- Copy of the communication through which the Embassy in Mexico of the applicant's country of nationality or residence notifies the foreigner that the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Affairs (SRE) received authorization from the competent national authorities, in the case of foreigners who wish to enter Mexico to participate in scientific research projects and/or collect samples in Mexican territory or waters under Mexican jurisdiction.

The communication must contain the following information:

- Full name and nationality of the applicant,
- Official name of the organization or public or private institution inviting the foreigner,
- Detailed information on the activity to be conducted or the project in which the foreigner will participate, and estimated length or approximate completion date of the activity.

e) Studies in Mexico:

- Original and copy of the letter of acceptance from an institution belonging to the National Education System for courses, studies or research project with a duration of less than 180 days. The letter should contain the following information:
 - Applicant's full name,
 - Level, degree and area of studies the applicant will enroll in,
 - Name of the courses, starting and completion dates, and cost,
 - Name, registration number and address of the school or institution belonging to the National Education System, **and**
- Economic solvency to cover school tuition and living expenses during the applicant's stay in Mexico, that can be proven with:
 - Original and copy of investment documents or bank account statements for the last six months, showing a monthly average balance of 9,700 SEK, or
 - Original and copy of documents showing monthly income or scholarship for at least 5,000 SEK after taxes during the last six months.

Note: Economic solvency may be proven by the applicant or by his/her parents or guardians as long as the applicant is not over the age of 25, or with a letter from the institution where the applicant will study, confirming that s/he has been awarded a scholarship.

Important Notes:

This visa is for foreigners who wish to enter Mexico to engage in non- remunerated activities** for a period not exceeding 180 days.

** Tourism, transit, business, studies, journalism, technical assistance, etc.

- ✓ Citizens of the following countries *do not need a visa*.

- ✓ Also, no visa is required for any foreigner, regardless of his/her nationality, who has:
 - a) A document confirming that she/he has permanent residence in Canada, USA, Japan, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, or any of the of the Schengen countries, **or**
 - b) A valid visa for the United States of America.

- ✓ The Consular Section of the Embassy of Mexico in Sweden **works by appointment only.**

Once the applicant has all the documents required, s/he needs to send them scanned via e-mail to info@embamex.se or consulado@embamex.se to request an appointment for the consular interview, submit the original documents and pay the consular fee in cash.
