



MEXICAN VISA

TEMPORARY STUDENT VISA

Foreigners who wish to enter, and remain in Mexico, as temporary student for a period greater than 180 days, to attend courses, pursue studies, or conduct research projects at an educational institution belonging to the National Educational System in Mexico, must comply with the following requirements:

REQUIREMENTS

1) Visa application form	Duly filled in English or Spanish (Latin characters) and signed by the applicant. (Download here).
2) Passport (Original and Photocopy)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Original, valid at least six months from the intended date of entry into Mexico.• Photocopy, good quality of the personal data pages that contain the following information: Passport number, signature, validity period.• Original and photocopies of previous passports, visas and entry stamps.
3) Photo	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One recent (no more than 30 days) colour photo• Size: 3.5 x 4 cm, white background, NO DIGITAL RETOUCH (NO PHOTOSHOP)• The face must be uncovered, without glasses or any kind of accessories/decorations.
4) Proof of legal stay in Viet Nam (Original and Photocopy)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only for applicants who are not Vietnamese citizens.• Permanent Residence Card, Temporary Residence Card, Valid Visa issued by Vietnamese migration authorities.
5) Supporting documents	<p><u>Economic Solvency: - Chose one Option -</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Last 12-monthly <u>bank statements</u> and a letter from the bank specifying the account opening date and financial balance. This documentation must be issued on the same month as the scheduled appointment and must be <u>duly signed</u> and <u>stamped by the bank</u>, OR



	<p>2. Official documents that prove a monthly income from employment, pensions or scholarships (last 6 months). Original pay slips must be stamped and signed by the company/institution or pension in charge. In case of a letter, it must be issued on letterhead paper and stating the applicant's grant, the institution/company's contact details and the name and position of the person that signs. It has to be issued on the same month as the scheduled appointment.</p> <p>School Letter – Mandatory -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ORIGINAL invitation letter from the institution where the applicant intends to study, with the following elements:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Full name and nationality of the visa applicant;▪ Degree and area of study that will be pursued;▪ Name of the course, start and end dates of the course;▪ Purpose of the organization or private institution;▪ Full address and contact information of the school or institution.
<p>FAMILY UNIT</p>	<p>Holder of a Student Visa or Student Card – Chose one option accordingly -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Spouse or common-law partner: marriage certificate or common law certificate or equivalent.b. Son or daughter: birth certificate of the childc. Parents: birth certificate of the applicant (minors)d. Child of the spouse or common-law partner or equivalent: applicant's birth certificate and marriage certificate or common-law certificate. <p>Resident Card or Visa – Mandatory –</p>



	<p>Economic solvency to support the family – Mandatory – Chose one Option</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Last 12-monthly <u>bank statements</u> and a letter from the bank specifying the account opening date and financial balance. This documentation must be issued on the same month as the scheduled appointment and must be <u>duly signed and stamped by the bank</u>, OR2. Official documents that prove a monthly income from employment, pensions or scholarships (last 6 months). Original pay slips must be stamped and signed by the company/institution or pension in charge. In case of a letter, it must be issued on letterhead paper and stating the applicant's grant, the institution/company's contact details and the name and position of the person that signs. It has to be issued on the same month as the scheduled appointment.
<p>6) Application processing fee</p>	<p>Payment in cash, <u>exact amount in US Dollars</u>. The fee is to be paid at the appointment date. (Application processing fee here)</p>

If compliance with all requirements, a valid single-entry visa will be issued. Once the applicant has entered Mexican territory, she or he must request the Temporary Resident Card, within the first 30 calendar days, at the National Migration Institute (INM).

Family Unity Applications may only be accepted at a Consular Office if the foreigner, with temporary or permanent resident status in Mexico, or Mexican citizen, is present with the family member at the time the application is submitted.



IMPORTANT NOTES

- It is the applicant's responsibility to COMPLETELY provide the abovementioned requirements the day of the interview.
THE EMBASSY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THE APPOINTMENT IF THE DOCUMENTATION IS INCOMPLETE.
- The Embassy reserves the right to request further documentation.
- Documents in any language different to English must be translated into Spanish by a certified translation office and duly legalized. The original document must also be presented along with its translation.
- Documents (bank statements, letters, etc.) issued in countries other than Viet Nam have to be duly legalized at the Mexican Embassy or Consulate in country where the document was issued, **OR** apostilled by the country of origin, if it is a member of the Hague Apostille Convention.
- According to Mexico's Migration Law, **the visa does not guarantee the entry into Mexico**: the final admission is subject to the approval by the migratory and sanitary authorities at the point of entry.

VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Visa applications will only be accepted with a scheduled appointment.
- The Embassy will set an appointment on the earliest available date.
THERE ARE NO URGENT APPOINTMENTS.
- The visa application is processed only at the Embassy of Mexico in Viet Nam, located in **HANOI**.
- Present complete required documents (original and copies) on appointment date. The Embassy reserves the right not to process incomplete applications.
- Applicants are responsible to present all required documents as indicated on the Visa Section of the Embassy's website.
- There will be no prior review of documents once a visa application is submitted.
- Submission of applications and collection of visas are strictly **personal**.



MÉXICO
EMBAJADA EN VIETNAM

- The application processing fee must be paid in cash, **IN DOLLARS ONLY** when submitting the application at the Consular Section of the Embassy (banknotes in good condition issued after 2013). Payment is **NOT REFUNDABLE** regardless of the visa application result.
- The visa will be subject to approval after the consular interview. The Embassy has up to 10 (TEN) working days to issue the visa application result.
- The Consular Section does not issue express visas.
- Admission of entry to Mexico will be determined exclusively by the Immigration Authority at the point of entry.
